3.21 #25, TEXACO CHEMICAL COMPANY

Location: The Texaco Chemical Co. landfill is owned by a private entity, and is located north Austin, at 7114 N. Lamar Blvd.

Extent: The location map for this landfill in the 1984 URM report shows the area of this landfill to be a roughly triangular area in an open field adjacent to the railroad tracks.

Remediation: A portion of the landfill, if not all, achieved final closure in March 2002 under Risk Reduction Standard No. 2 in accordance with 30 TAC 335.

Current Condition: Current conditions associated with this site do not appear to pose a material concern to human health or the environment, or represent a regulatory violation.
