

# NORTH ACRES STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS

WALNUT CREEK WATERSHED

PROTECTING LIVES & PROPERTY

The Watershed Protection Department is working on a project to reduce flood risk in the North Acres neighborhood. The first phase has been completed. It restored curbs and gutters along several streets to improve drainage. During the second phase, we will install storm drain pipes and inlets and

restore the remaining gutters. The new storm drain system will reduce flooding on the streets. We are also incorporating Austin Water’s Newport Ave. Pipeline Renewal Project. It includes replacing a cast iron water main on Newport Ave. from Middle Fiskville Road to Horace Dr. with a new PVC water main.

### Estimated Timeline for Phase 2

- Storm drain system is currently being designed.
- Construction plans finalized in early 2023. Begin process to hire contractor.
- Construction starts in late 2023.

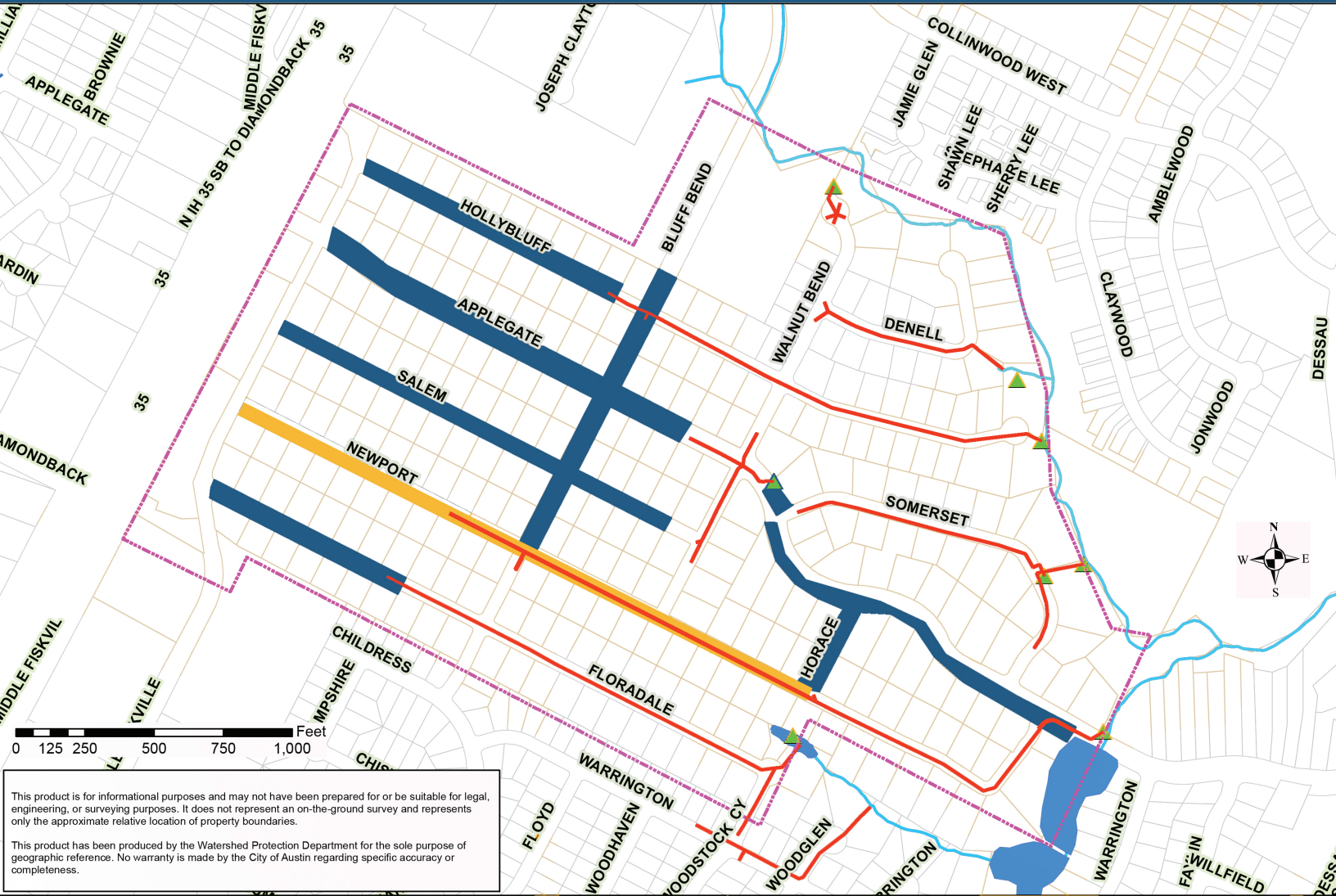
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## WALNUT CREEK WATERSHED
