WHEREAS, the City Council adopted a funding plan as part of the FY 2008-2009 budget that allocated \$1 million to Holly Neighborhood Programs; and

WHEREAS, \$100,000 of the funds were allocated to the Holly Neighborhood Grants Assistance Program; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN:

That the City Manager is directed to allocate \$100,000 from the Holly Neighborhood Grants Assistance Program for the following programs:

- Austin Latino Music Association \$5,000 for the enhancement and promotion of the Trail of Tejano Legends for area residents, visitors to the City and residents of Austin.
- Ballet East Dance Company \$20,000 for after-school dance programs for students at Metz and Sanchez Elementary Schools, Martin Middle School and children at Metz Recreation Center
- Lorraine "Grandma" Camacho Activity Center \$5000 for computer lab upgrades and expansion of lab for use by area residents of all ages.
- Creative Arts Austin \$5000 for the "Believe in Me" program for Metz Elementary School students
- East Cesar Chavez Neighborhood Planning Team \$10,000 to relocate
 El Jardin Alegre, the neighborhood community garden for area
 residents, and the establishment of the Festival Beach Community

- Garden for residents of the Holly and East Cesar Chavez Neighborhoods
- East Cesar Chavez Neighborhood Planning Team \$5000 to continue development of historic preservation through creation of a Local Historic District.
- East Cesar Chavez Neighborhood Planning Team \$700 for 19th
 Annual Haskell Street Halloween Block Party.
- GEN Austin Girls Empowerment Network \$3300 to help underwrite "clubGEN" and "Girls Now!" programs for female students at Martin Middle School.
- Girl Scouts of Central Texas (GSCTX) \$4000 to help underwrite the "You Go Girl!" program for Latinas ages 8-17 from low-income, low-resource backgrounds in the Holly neighborhood who are unlikely to participate in volunteer-led troops.
- Latinitas \$10,000 to help underwrite the "Maximizing East Side
 Technology" programs for Latina youth at Brooke, Metz, Sanchez,
 Zavala, Ortega and Allison Elementary Schools, and at Martin Middle
 School; workshops at Cepeda and Terrazas Libraries; and programs and
 events at the Mexican American Cultural Center (M.A.C.C.).
- Latinas Unidas Por El Arte \$2500 to help underwrite 3 projects at
 Zavala Elementary School, post production of documentary "Zavala
 Girls," provide opportunities in film and theater for two young Zavala
 actresses and help fund a theater production of "She Flies."
- Metz Recreation Center Advisory Board -- \$10,000 to help underwrite the "Arts Renaissance Project," after-school art and music

- programming, fund scholarships for day and summer camps and other programs at Metz Recreation Center for area children of all ages.
- Sanchez Elementary School Sally Duncan, Teacher, and Azucena Garcia, Principal – \$4500 to help fund construction of a sundial, garden, sitting area and educational kiosks at Sanchez Elementary School for students and area residents.
- Raul Valdez, artist \$15,000 to help underwrite an "Artist in Residence" program at Sanchez Elementary School.
