- Altars will be set up in 4'1" wide spaces along partitioned glass walls (each partition is 1'10" wide.)
- Altars may contain original photographs and documents at the participants' discretion (We recommend duplicates.)
- Food is allowed, but must be replenished or thrown out throughout the duration of the display.
- Some common objects include photographs, candles, cempasúchil (marigolds), papel December 1 picado, pan de muerto, and sugar skulls.

Altar construction begins. Participants can work on their altars from 10am to 5pm up to the day of the event.

Last day altars are open to the public.

December 3-7

Participants may begin to remove altars Dec 3, and must finish by Dec 7.
