Public Input Agenda

The public meeting of the Citizen Review Panel will be held in the Board and Commission Room at 7:00 p.m. The following is the agenda:

- 1. 2014-0775: The complainant alleges that an APD officer took law enforcement action while off-duty and used forced that caused an injury.
- 2. 2014-0685: The complainant alleges that the Organized Crime Division of the APD failed to investigate an anonymous tip before making contact with him at his workplace.
- 3. 2014-0595: The complainant alleges that an APD Detective and Sergeant failed to investigate sexual assault allegations.
- 4. 2014-0778: The complainant alleges that an APD Lieutenant retaliated against her for filing a complaint.
- 5. 2014-0550: The complainant alleges officers failed to take law enforcement actions to remove a motel guest.
- 6. 2014-0667: The complainant alleges that officers failed to help him when TXDOT was doing construction near his motel.
- 7. 2014-0669: The complainant alleges that officers failed to serve his interests as a business owner and remove someone with a malfunctioning car on his property.
- 8. 2014-0670: The complainant alleges that officers failed to evict a person from his motel that he felt was a threat to him.
- 9. 2014-0750: Complainant alleges he was racially profiled when he was stopped by an APD officer and that he did not commit the traffic violation for which he was stopped.

10. 2014-0920: Complainant claims her vehicle was hit by an APD officer driving an APD vehicle in a private parking lot.
