2. Case 2013-0951: Complainant states that during a traffic stop officers were rude and unprofessional towards him.
3. 2013-0995: Complainant alleges that a detective assigned to his case did not thoroughly investigate all available evidence.
4. Case 2013-1088: Complainant states chain of command retaliated against him for filing a complaint against another Austin Police Department Detective.
