

NOTICE OF EXPLANATION

FLOODPLAIN REVIEW

FINAL NOTICE

City of Austin Public Works Department intends to carry out the following proposed actions that may affect or be affected by the 100-year floodplain. Pursuant to the requirements of Executive Orders 11988 and 11990, the Police Jury completed an evaluation concerning potential impacts on the floodplain and possible alternative actions.

Action: Bridge Approach Rehabilitation – Due to the large percentage of deteriorated bridge approach within the jurisdiction of Onion Creek flood plain, the City of Austin Public Works Department plans to repair the River Plantation Drive bridge at an approximate cost of \$582,558

The City of Austin Public Works Department has concluded there isn't a practicable alternative to this action. The deteriorated condition of the bridge is a danger to the health and safety of area residents and is a detriment to travel in the area.

There will not be any adverse impacts due to the proposed activity. Repair of bridge is not considered incompatible within the floodplain & repairing the bridge will allow residents safer access to other parts of the area.
