

Update on Demolition Permit Notifications



To our neighbors, stakeholders and community:

We recently sent you an update about ongoing improvements to the demolition permitting process for the City of Austin. In that communication, we mentioned that the Development Services Department (DSD) plans to present a proposed ordinance to Council later this month that will address both mandatory notifications and utility requirements associated with demolition activities.

Please be aware that the Austin City Council has moved that discussion to September. This item is currently scheduled for consideration at the September 17 meeting. If you are interested in following or commenting on this item, please [check the Council agenda](#) closer to the meeting date to ensure it is still on the agenda.

As stated in our previous communication, DSD has released an online tool that makes it possible to receive notices about [demolition permitting activities](#) that interest you.

Using the [Austin Build + Connect \(AB+C\) portal](#), you can subscribe to receive notifications based on your preferred geographic designation: Address, Community Registry group, Council District or Zip Code. You will be able to view demolition permit information either on the [Property Profile](#) map or on AB+C.

The addition of this notification tool is part of a broader ongoing effort by DSD. The Austin City Council provided direction to redesign and improve the demolition permitting process to ensure:

- Appropriate reviews take place prior to demolition activities.
- Appropriate safety measures are in place prior to demolition activities.
- Adequate notification is given to interested parties.
