The Art in Public Places Program is seeking visual artists, ideally artists with practical experience with materials common to public art, fabrication and an understanding of the requirements of art in the public realm to serve on the AIPP Panel, a volunteer standing subcommittee of the Arts Commission which is charged with making recommendations regarding the Art in Public Places program and related issues. All AIPP Panel members need to possess knowledge of contemporary visual art, trends in the public art field, and must be willing and able to serve in a panel process without conflict of interest. You will be asked to:

- Attend one AIPP Panel meeting every month;
- Attend AIPP-sponsored events, as available, including public art dedications, exhibition openings, lectures, tours of potential public art sites, project information meetings, and public hearings;
- Possibly serve as a juror for AIPP projects; and
- Represent the AIPP program by recruiting qualified artists, jurors and panelists to
 participate in the program; and by sharing information with your colleagues about public
 art commissions.
