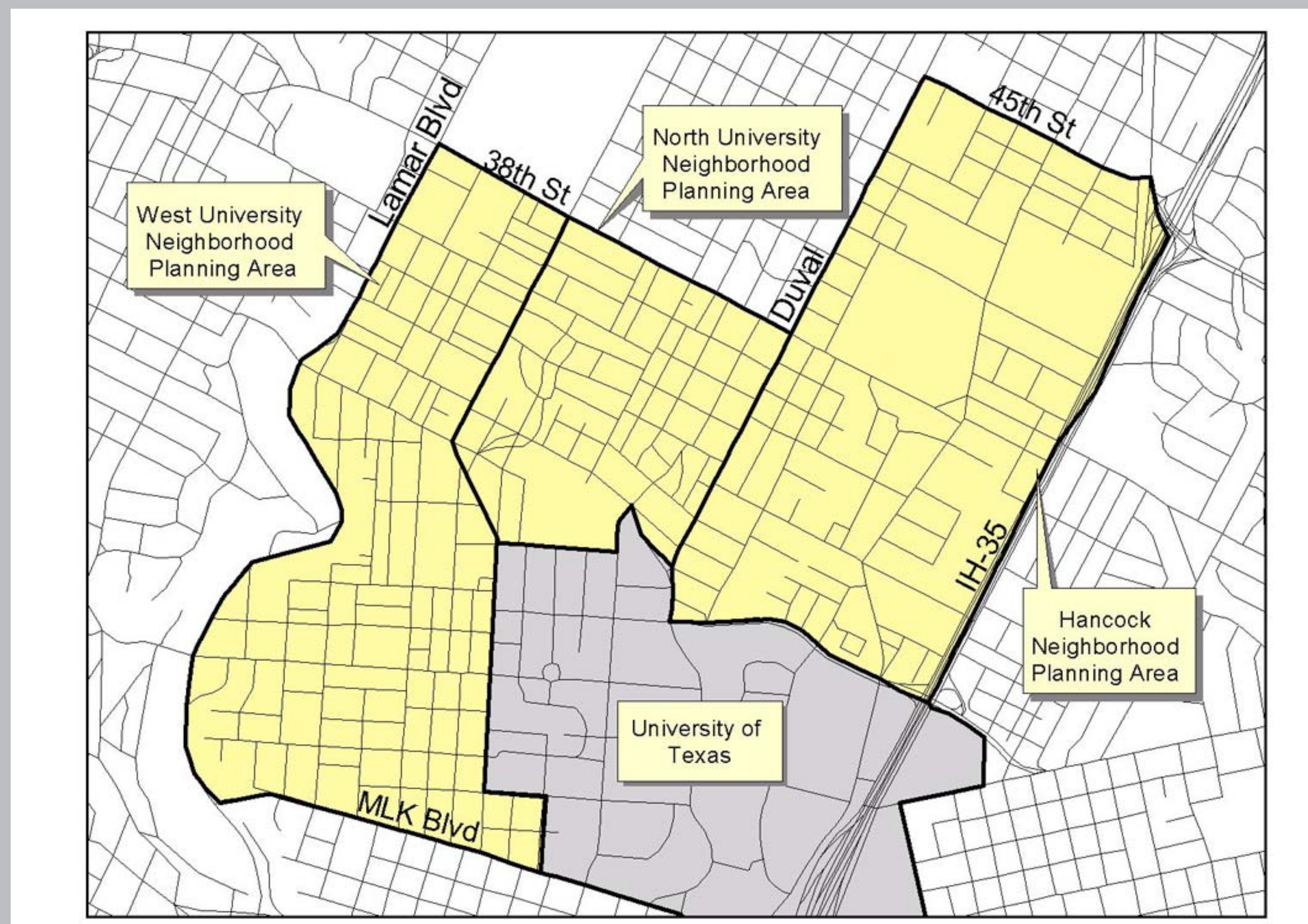

Neighborhood Planning Area

Plan goals/recommendations influencing the Guadalupe corridor:

- New development or redevelopment along Guadalupe Street from 21st to 26th Streets should reflect the more modest character of the majority of buildings along Guadalupe.
- The Drag should become a more pedestrian-friendly place.
- 24th Street should become a more pedestrian-oriented “Main Street” for West Campus.
- Rio Grande Street, like 24th Street, should serve as a “Main Street” for West Campus. It is the only street that completely bisects West Campus south to north in a straight line and links MLK Boulevard with 29th Street.
- The residents of West Campus and the West University Neighborhood should have safe and shaded pedestrian and bicycle access to shops, restaurants, and transit along Guadalupe Street and to the University of Texas. To this end, sidewalks should be considered equally if not more important public pathway as the roads they line.
- The residents of the combined planning area should have safe pedestrian and bicycle access to Guadalupe Street and the University of Texas.
- Improve the safety of existing bicycle lanes along Guadalupe Street.
- Provide convenient and safe pedestrian crossings at arterial roadways.
- Install bike lockers on Guadalupe Street near the West Mall crosswalk and bus stops.
