Dogs and Restaurants: The Do's and Don'ts!



Dogs are not allowed inside food establishments, even at times the business is not open for customers.

**Exception:* Service dogs for the seeing and hearing impaired are allowed to accompany owners.

DOGS PERMITTED IN OUTDOOR DINING AREAS: Austin City Code Sec. 10-3-124

A food establishment may allow customers to bring their dogs to an outdoor dining area if all the following are met:

- 1) food establishment posts a sign in a prominent place stating dogs are allowed in the outdoor dining area;
- 2) customers/dogs access the outdoor dining area directly from outside of the food establishment;
- 3) dogs do not enter inside the food establishment;
- 4) customers keep dogs on leashes and control dogs;
- 5) dogs are not allowed on seats, tables, countertops, or similar surfaces;
- 6) food is not prepared in the outdoor dining area, and the only open food allowed is food that is being served to customers.



On-Site Storage of Ashtrays and Smoking Accessories In Places Where Smoking is Prohibited

EHSD will not enforce City Code Chapter 10-6-8 (C) against establishment operators and employers when "ashtrays or other smoking accessories" are observed by EHSD staff to be stored on-site in places where smoking is prohibited if the following conditions are met:

Ashtrays/smoking accessories are:

- 1) Not visible to patrons.
- 2) Not accessible to patrons.
- 3) Not for use in places where smoking is prohibited.

The City of Austin health inspectors make every attempt to educate during inspections. There are times however, when questions arise after the inspector is gone. The Environmental Health Services Division offers a complaint/request phone line that is staffed by a health inspector during business hours.
