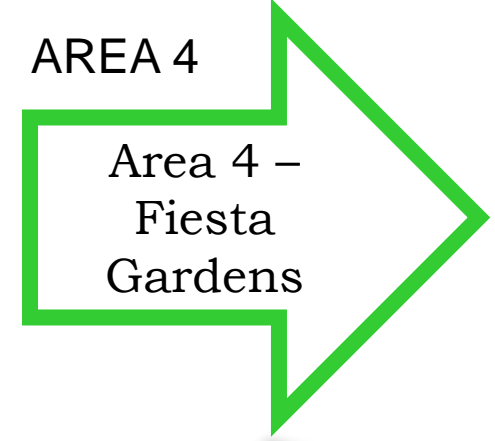
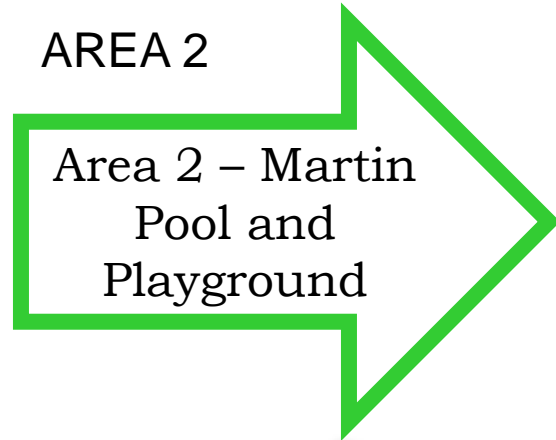
# Original Study Areas

# Area 1 – Festival Beach Restroom The Trail Foundation

- Replace Existing Restroom

## Project Budget:

- \$500,000.00

- *Design Development Completed*
- *Spring 2019*

- *New Pool Fence – Mid November 2018*

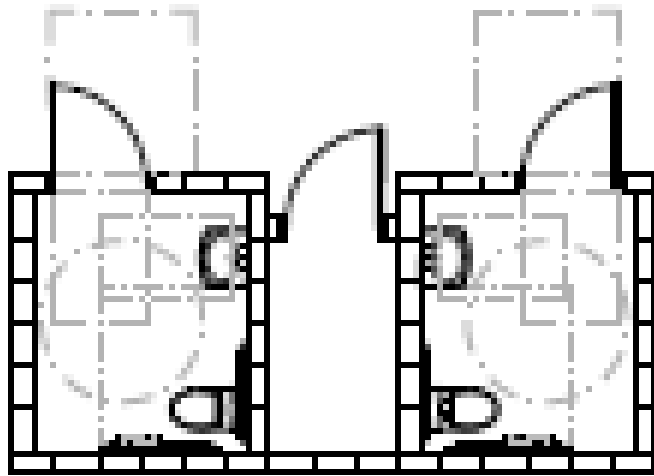

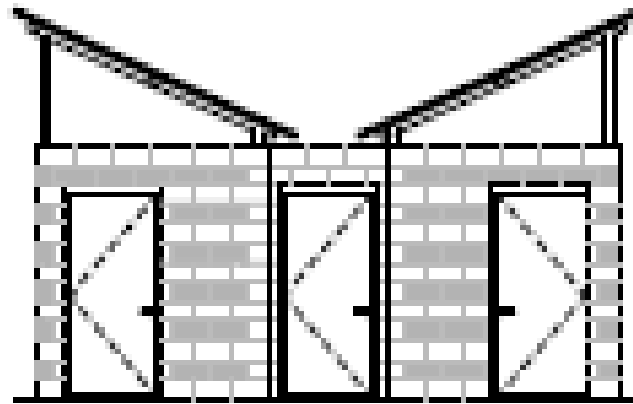

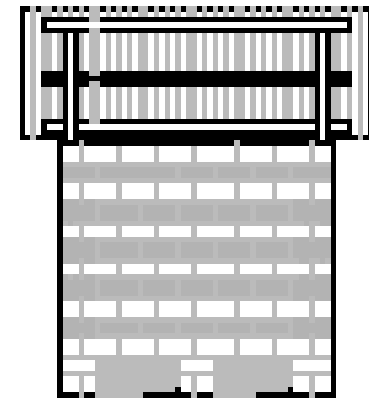
## New Restroom Facility

New Accessible walkways along Nash Hernandez Senior Road from Festival Beach to Chicon Street, including crosswalks

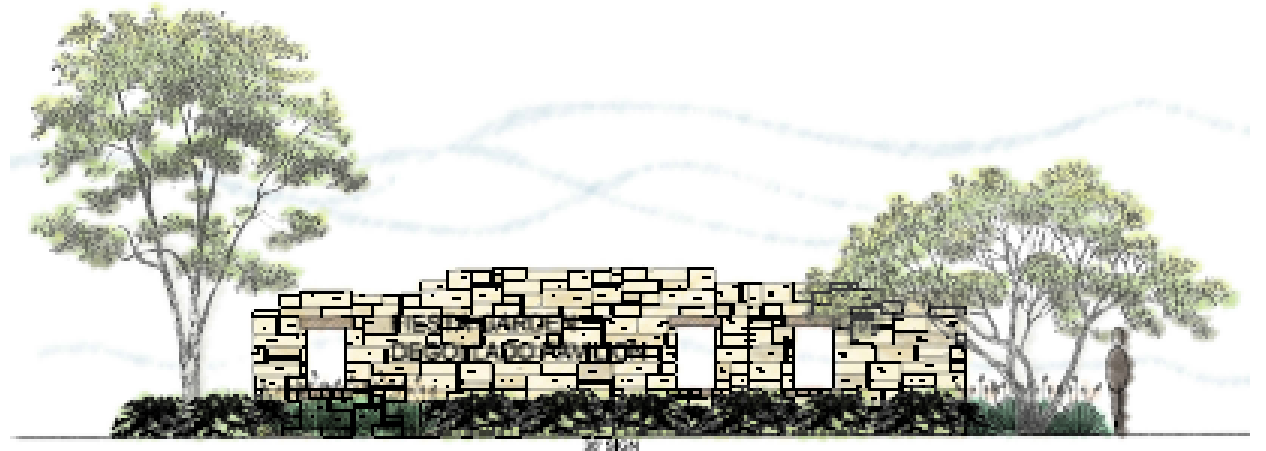




# Area 3 – Degolado Pavilion

## Primary Goals:

- Provide a hand washing station

- *Permitting – Site Plan Correction*
- *Construction Start – Late Fall 2018*
- *Completion – Early Spring 2019*

- Remove Fencing to allow for community use



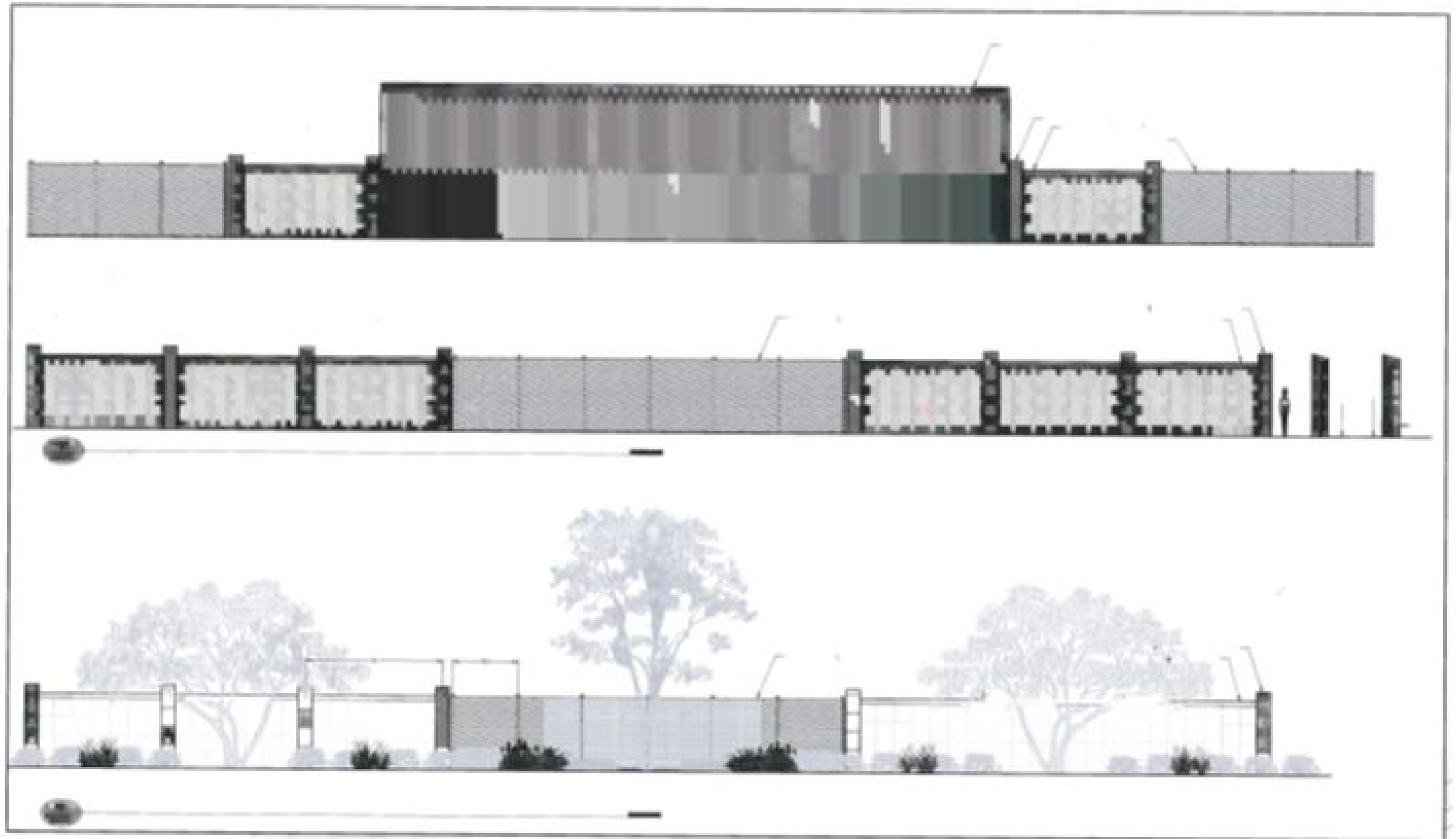
