

- New Restroom Facility












Area 2 – Martin Playground and Pool cont: New Restroom Facility

including crosswalks










Area 3 – Degolado Pavilion

Schedule for Completion: Need community input on proposed entry statement

- Permitting Site Plan Correction
- Construction Start Late Fall 2018
- Completion Early Spring 2019

- Remove Fencing to allow for community use




