I hereby enter a plea of “no contest” to the violation of _____ and waive my right to trial. I request the Court allow me to complete a Deferred Disposition sentence for this case. I understand if I successfully complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition by the due date established by the court, my case will be dismissed. If I do not complete the terms of the Deferred Disposition, I will be sent a notice to appear in court to show cause why I did not complete the terms of this deferral. If cause is not sufficient, I understand that the Deferred Disposition will be revoked and I will be found guilty of the offense.

I understand the Deferred Disposition option is not available if I possess a provisional driver license. I understand that the deferral period is **90 days** from the date this form is postmarked and agree to the terms of the Deferred Disposition, which are:

1. The payment must be made immediately in the amount of \$250 plus collection and/or warrant fees, if applicable. You cannot pay on-line and must attach a check or money order at the time this form is submitted. Contact the court if you cannot pay immediately **and**
2. Commit no disabled parking offenses within the City limits of Austin, Texas **and**
3. Notify the Court in writing of any change of address.
