## Purpose

- Assist drivers who have lost licenses due to Department of Public Safety surcharges associated with Austin Municipal Court cases

## Process

- UT students will perform intake and assessments and assist with financial forms
- Pro bono attorneys will assist in resolving outstanding cases, including seeking community service or hardship waivers, and present information for indigency determinations.
- Judges will conduct indigency determinations at an on-site hearing

- Driver's licenses will **not** be reinstated onsite
- Spanish interpreters will be available
