2014 Summer Teen Workshops

Teenagers ages 13 to 17 will have the opportunity to participate in one of our workshops where they can sharpen their artistic and technical skills or develop a new one.

Early Drop-Off is available \$50/session M-F, 7:45am —8:45am

Session 1: Comic Art — Ink and Digital Techniques

June 16 —June 27 M—F 9am to 5pm, \$300

This is an ideal course for students who want to explore the various types of comic art that exist in different parts of Asia, focusing on Japan, Taiwan, South Korea, China, and Hong Kong. Students will learn how to utilize special materials to create their very own unique and individual characters, storyboard, and chapterization. Students will learn inking techniques for drawing on paper as well as digital techniques for drawing on the computer.

Session 2: Painting Asia

June 30 —July 11 M—F 9am to 5pm, \$275

(No class on July 4)

This workshop will provide a unique opportunity for students to learn about and practice various painting concepts that were developed in Asia— Ink Wash, Scroll Painting, Silk Painting, etc.

Session 3: Game Maker

July 14—July 25 M—F 9am to 5pm, \$300

This workshop is not only for gaming enthusiasts, but also for students who are interested in computer game programming. Participants will have the opportunity to learn about the competitive world of eSports in East and Southeast Asian culture as they create their own games. They will be given a step-by-step walk through as they learn to create characters, build walls, warp to new levels, add rooms, backgrounds, music, sound effects, and much more. At the end of the two week session, students will receive a copy of their game, the Game Maker LITE software, and their own custom walk through guide and resource folder so that they can continue to expand their computer game programming skills at home.

Session 4: Scratch Animation

July 28 —August 8 M—F 9am to 5pm, \$300

The Scratch Animation workshop is perfect for students who are interested in learning about animation in Japanese pop culture. Students will learn about the history and stories behind the art of Japanese anime. They will be given the opportunity to design, write, and develop their own animation using Scratch, a visual programming language developed by the MIT Media Lab. We will explore topics connected to Japanese anime such as plot development, character creation, social issues, and much more. This is a great opportunity for students to get introduced to programming and to tap into their creativity and imagination. The curriculum emphasizes mathematics and literacy skills while fostering creativity and applied learning.
