NEW! Woodcut Printmaking 101

Enjoy the ancient art of woodcuts with wood/linoleum as well as the history of printmaking from the instructor who has made woodcut prints for over 22 years! The goal of this class is to learn how to prepare, carve, and print a block onto paper as well as make editions of your prints. Students will first learn how to print in black and white then use a registration process to make a 2-color print. All printing will be done by hand. The final project will be a trade portfolio where students exchange prints. Class held in 5W. Limit 12 students.

No prior experience is necessary, only a desire to have fun and create. Student must be 18 yrs old and up. Class in 5W. Limit 6 students.

Surface Design Basics
