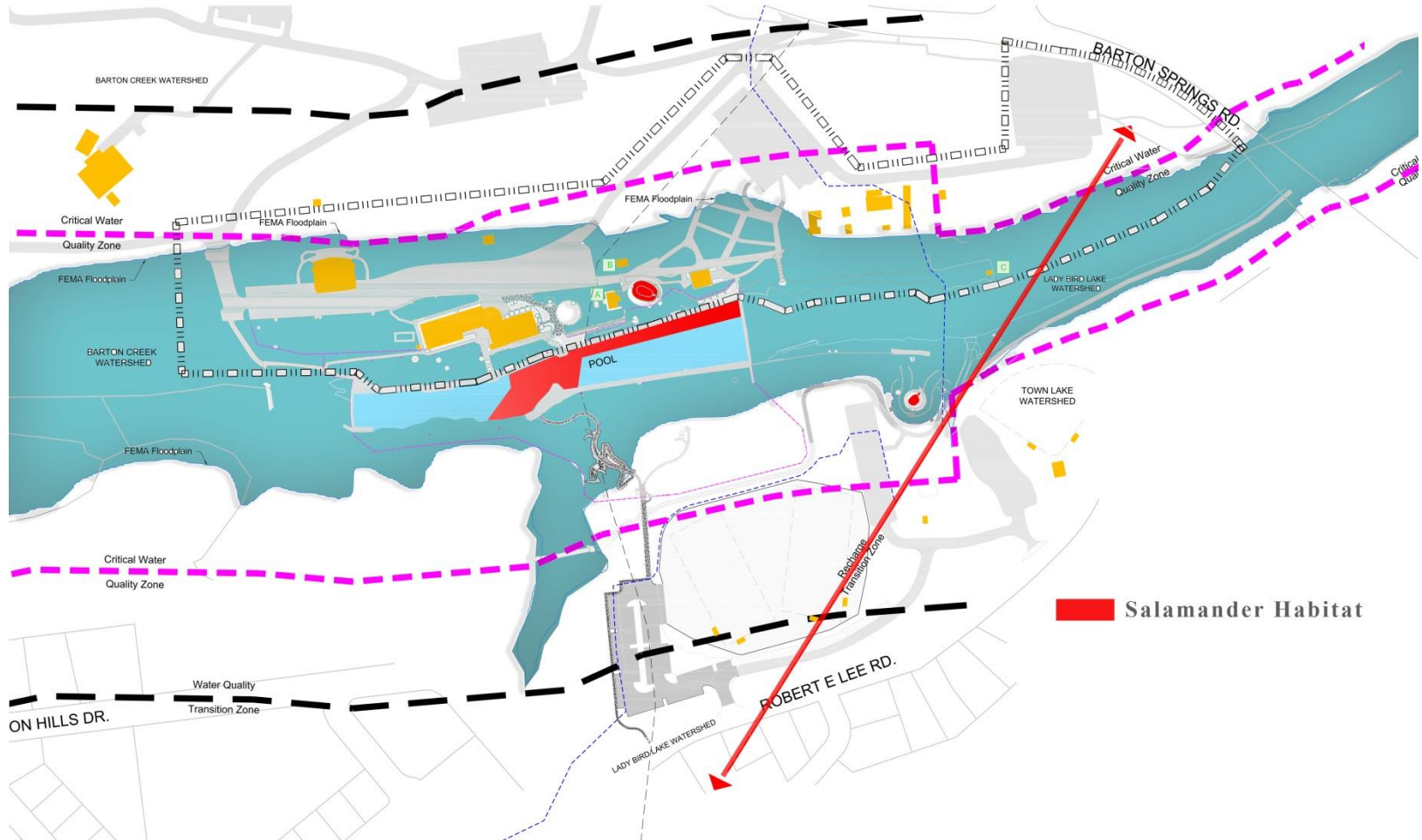
ZONE PLAN

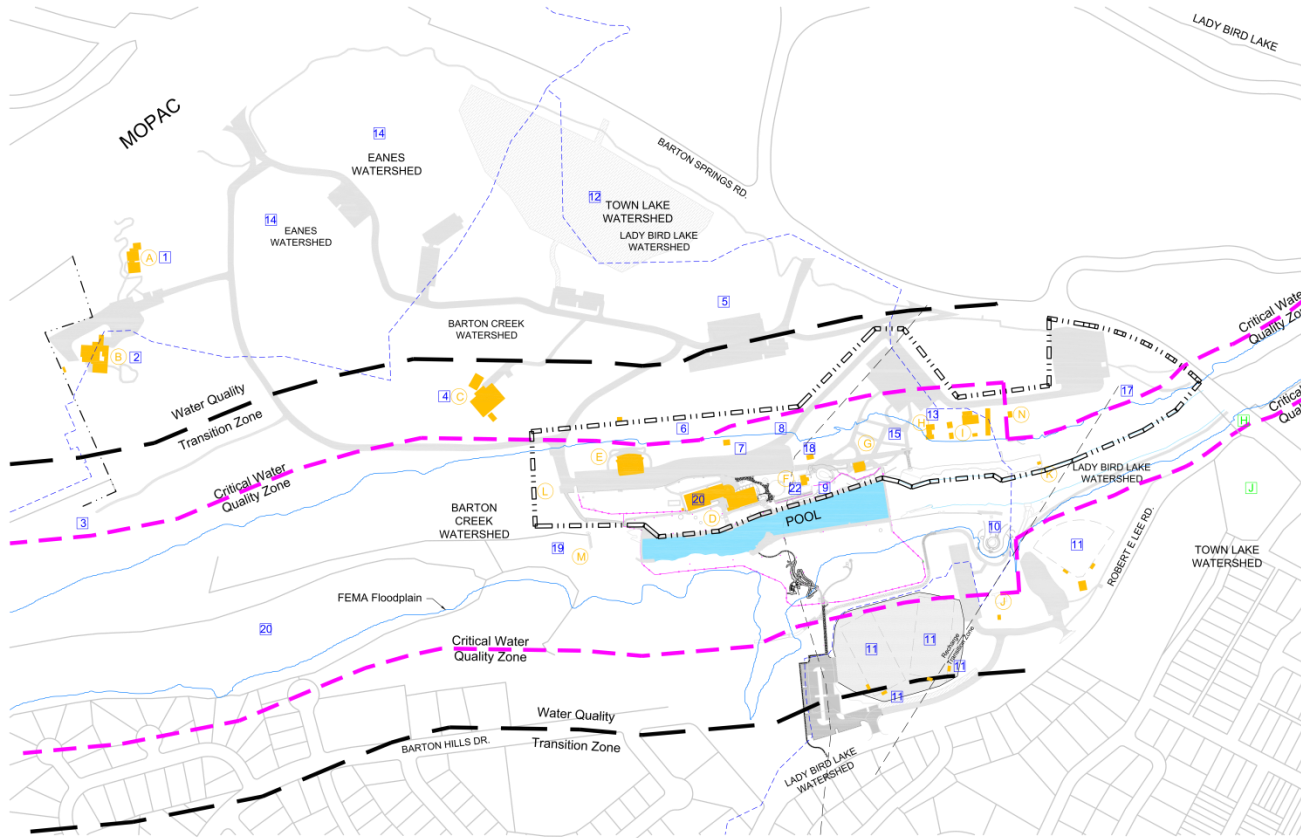

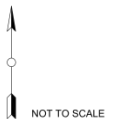

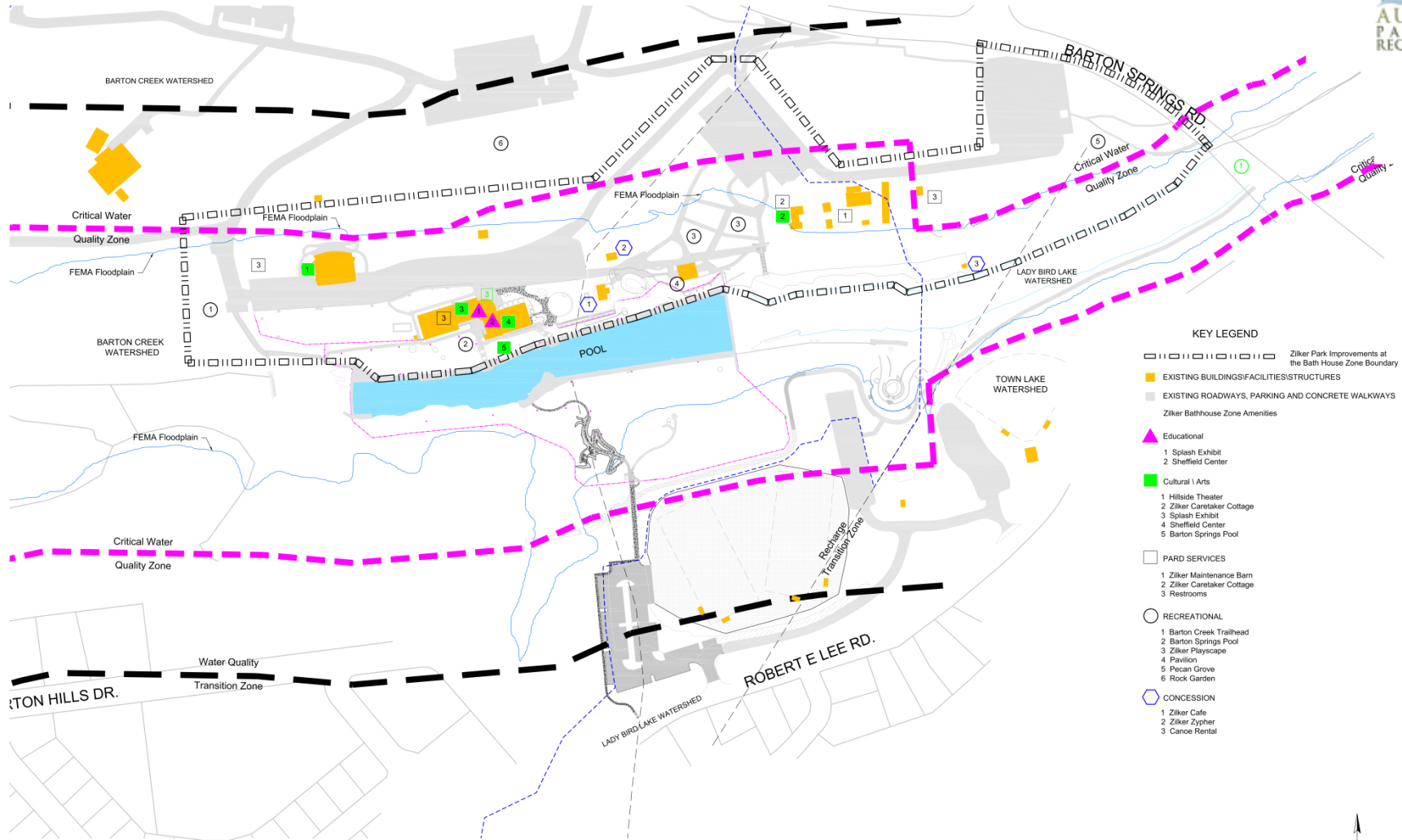
Zilker Park is a district under the National Register of Historic Places. The Zilker Park Historic District consist of a cohesive group of resources developed between 1917 and 1947 as an urban park and recreation facility. The park's resources consist of prolific works from the 1930's Civil Works Administration and Civilian Conservation Corps along with later improvements. The 350 acre park as a whole retains the historic landscape characteristics integral to its intended design and use, therefore retaining a high degree of integrity as a designed historic landscape in terms of location, design, setting, materials, workmanship, feeling, and association. There are numerous State of Texas Antiquities Landmarks as well as City of Austin designated Historic Landmarks.

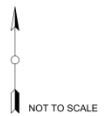

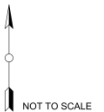
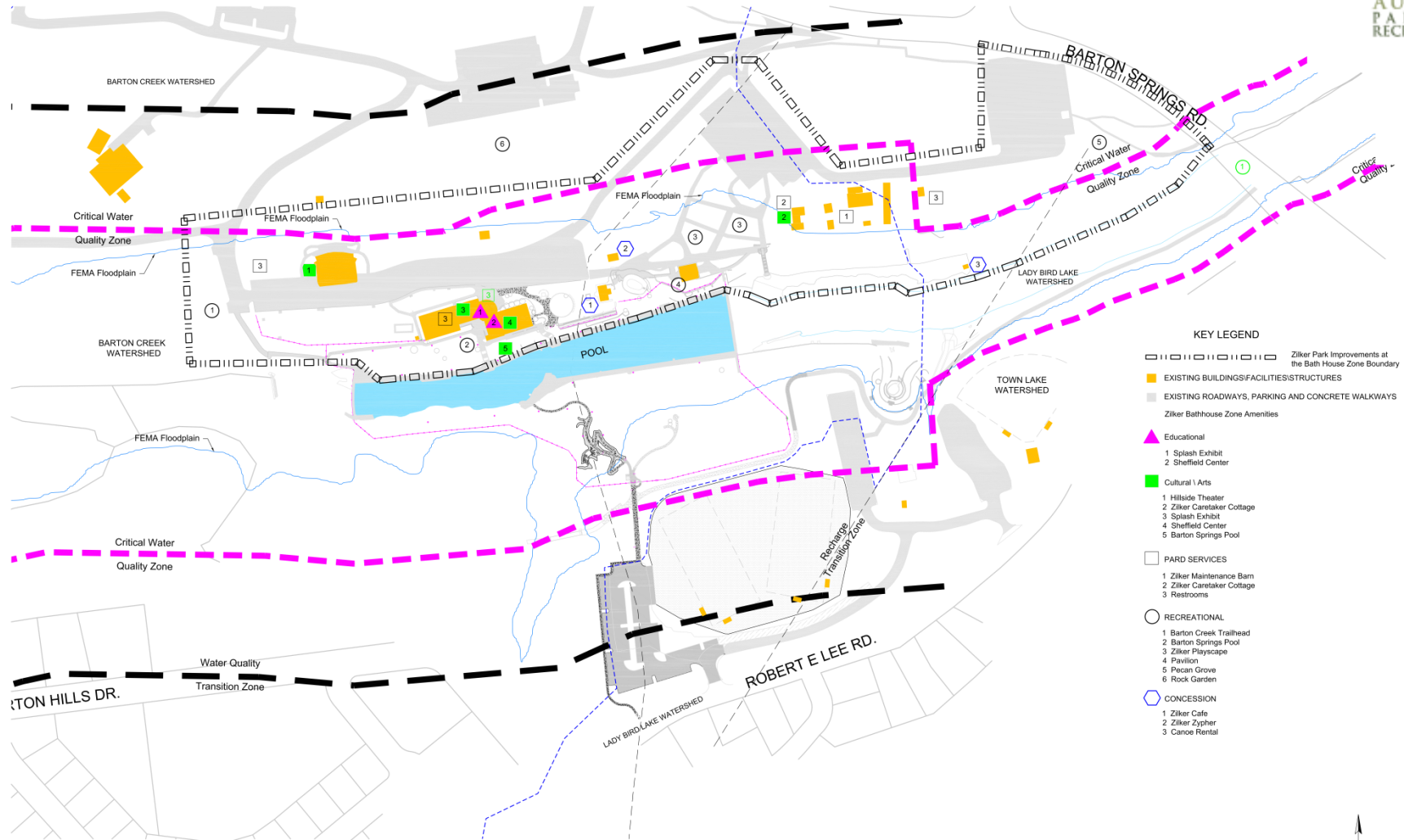
