The main thing is the pool has activity but is not a stressful environment upon entry. Bring back the vending machines for refreshments and the individual patron baskets for patrons to use or lockers for their valuables while swimming (these amenities were available during the 1970's - 1980's. Restrooms need to still remain open roof not covered to prevent mold and dampness when the lifeguards to clean up. And to maintain safety of the patrons and prevent anyone from getting hurt by intruders. The old design of the outside restrooms might be used for when movies are being shot as dressing rooms if film companies want to use the pool. During the fall and winter - use the pool for drive in movies, floor hockey, outdoor concerts and charge admissions to cover costs..
