

Rental Information

Oswaldo “AB” Cantu Pan American Recreation Center offers various rooms that are available for rental: gymnasium, arts and crafts room and the multi-purpose room. Also available for rental is an outdoor stage (currently under renovations). The stage will be available for rental after summer when all renovations will be complete. All rental requests need to be submitted in writing to the attention of the supervisor six months prior to the event. There is a \$200 refundable deposit for most rooms plus the fee. The fee can range from \$240—\$220 depending on the size of the room being rented and the amount of time re-

Registration Information and Policies

Refund / Transfer Policy

(unless otherwise indicated)

A full refund will be issued for all programs, if cancelled by Pan Am Recreation Center, or due to a personal injury or illness (medical verification will be requested). In the event that you need to withdraw from a class, the pro-rated activity fee, minus a \$35.00 processing fee, will be refunded. If the receipt amount is less than \$ 10.00, no refund will be issued. You may receive a credit serviceable for programs occurring within 90 days of withdrawal. Once a refund has been requested, it will take four to six weeks for processing, subsequently, a City of Austin check will be mailed to your address. Program attendance is the responsibility of the participants. Credit is not given for classes missed during a session. **PLEASE NOTE:** If your initial payment was by check, a front and back copy of that canceled check or bank statement must be presented before a refund can be processed.

Registration Procedures

Walk-in registrations are accepted on a first come, first served basis. Full payment is required for official registration (unless otherwise indicated). The front desk accepts registration Monday through Thursday, from 12:00 pm - 9:00 pm and Friday from 12:00 pm - 6:00 p.m.

Registration Fees

All class fees are due at registration time. Fees may be paid with cash, money orders, credit cards or checks. A valid driver's license is required when paying by check or credit card. Please make checks payable to the **City of Austin**. Currently, we ac-

Pan Am Recreation Center

In 1996, the center was named in honor of Oswaldo "A.B." Cantu, but still retains the original name Pan American to be known as the A.B. Cantu/Pan American Recreation Center. A.B. Cantu was a lifetime advocate of youth and amateur boxing in Austin. He was an employee of the Parks and Recreation Department for 28 years and was heavily involved in providing East Austin youth recreational activities. He founded the Pan American Boxing Club at the new center in 1956 when it officially opened.

In 1998, the Austin voters approved over \$2 million in Capital Improvement funds to build a second story to the A.B. Cantu/Pan American Recreation Center for expansion of the building's space for recreational programs. It was placed on the November bond election ballot at the urging of East Austin Community members. The project consisted of the renovation of the existing single story area and the addition of a new second floor. All exterior walls were torn out leaving only the existing perimeter walls and the existing single story portion of the building. Today the new building is ADA accessible and has an additional 6,314 feet. The new addition has a dance studio, computer lab, arts and crafts room and a multipurpose room. The existing gym was also given a facelift with a new wooden floor and new bleachers.

The park surrounding the recreation center is 5.3 acres. The amenities include a multipurpose sports field, outdoor tennis and basketball courts, a playscape and currently the outdoor hillside stage is going through renovations
