## Observed Holidays - No Reservation Periods

On a limited number of Federal Holidays or Observances and other dates, the Parks and Recreation Department does not coordinate reservations for picnic sites or facilities due to the high volume of public use. **On these dates, all picnic sites are first-come first-served. Facilities are NOT reserved on these days.**

**ALERT:** On holiday weekends, **PERMITS ARE NOT ISSUED** for moonwalks/rockwalls, or amplified sound (dj's, bands, stereos). These items are not ALLOWED in parks on observed holidays.
