Helpful Information to give when calling 911:

- Your name
- Subject's name
- Address for police to respond to
- Age, height, weight and clothing of subject
- · Medications subject may take
- Subject's diagnosis
- Any current or prior violent behavior
- Current or past drug use
- Triggers
- Current or past history of psychosis
- Current or past delusions/hallucinations
- Possible weapons subject may have (real or fake)
- What has helped de-escalate past situations

In the event of an emergency, or if you need immediate assistance, call 911.

In the event of a medical concern in conjunction with a mental health crisis, any local hospital emergency department can provide treatment
