

Sabine Street Promenade Traffic Control Notice & Project Update

On Thursday, December 13th, NO PARKING signs will be placed on Sabine Street from 5th to 6th Street and vehicles will have 48 hours to clear the upcoming construction area. The City's contractor plans to mobilize to the east side of Sabine Street from 5th to 6th Street on Saturday, December 15th. The contractor shall begin demolition and utility work in the 500 block. The loading dock and alley access shall be maintained throughout construction. The northbound travel lane from 5th Street onto Sabine Street will also be open. This phase is anticipated to be complete in March/April timeframe weather permitting.

5th Street Travel Lanes Reduced to a Single Eastbound Lane from Neches to IH 35 through end of December: City's contractor is planning to begin work on a wastewater line on 5th Street for the next two weeks or end of December. The two eastbound travel lanes on 5th Street shall resume January 1, 2019.

The overall project should be complete Summer 2019. Motorists are asked to use caution and be mindful of the work zone during this time. The City will provide updates to inform the public of any additional closures or upcoming changes to traffic controls related to this project.
