


Neighborhood Partnering Program Application Summary

Project Name: Skyview Pocket Park

Project location: W Skyview Road



Project Scope & Description

- Project will create a pocket park on West Skyview Road by removing asphalt at current dead end road.
- Project will remove a traffic barrier and add fencing at the Western edge of the new green area.
- Project will add a rain garden to the green space.
- Project feasibility has been reviewed and approved by staff at the Austin Transportation and Watershed Protection Departments.






- Neighborhood will be responsible for landscaping, installation of plants, sod, fruit trees, and signage design.
- Neighborhood will remove graffiti, pick up litter and re-stock the doggie bar dispenser.
- City of Austin will perform excavation, install new curb, rain garden, and berms, provide the sod, picnic table, composted soil, fence, ballards, fruit trees, plants and benches, install rain garden and berms, and remove willow.
- Letters of support were received from City of Austin’s Watershed Department and the Department of Public Safety.





Location of W Skyview Rd




Landing Plan View
