



2016 Mobility Bond: Urban Trails

Austin to Manor Trail Section 2

Lindell Lane to Ben E Fisher Park

OVERVIEW

The Austin to Manor Trail will be a 5.5 mile long trail beginning near Daffan Lane and ending near Ben E. Fisher Park in Manor, Texas. The trail will connect to the existing Southern Walnut Creek Trail and follow the proposed Capital Metro green line. Once complete, it will create an additional route for commuters between both cities.

PROJECT PURPOSE

Austin to Manor Trail Section 2 will connect to the completed portion of the Austin to Manor Trail at Lindell Lane, extending the trail to the city of Manor. The project includes a 2.9 mile, 12-foot wide concrete path that follows the Capital Metropolitan Transportation Authority railroad tracks northeast from Lindell Lane to Ben E. Fisher Park.

FUNDING

- \$4 M from the **2016 Mobility Bond**
- \$3.8 M from a **Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO)** grant
- \$1.26 M from Travis County
- \$372,539 from the 2012 Bond

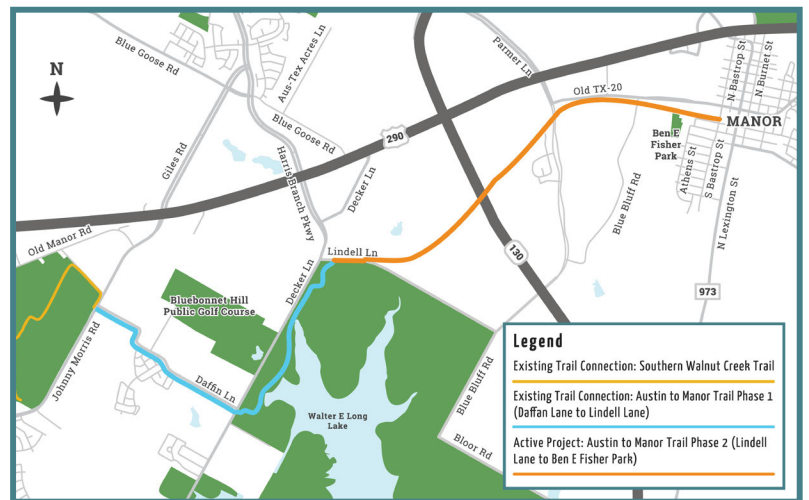
