

## Film Requirements:

- 10 minutes maximum length (optimal length is 1-5 min.)
- By an Austin-area filmmaker or commissioned through an Austin organization
- Original non-fiction or fiction work
- Filmed in Austin or highlights Austin-area topics or organizations
- *May not be selected by SXSW as part of its other Short Film Exhibitions*

## Examples of Film Submissions:

- Documentary about a local organization, place, issue, or historical event
- Music video featuring Austin bands
- Student film by Austin university, secondary, or elementary students
- Narrative set in and/or filmed in Austin
- Artistic video montage that highlights Austin

## Application:

## Selection Process:

A selection panel comprising project advisors, media experts, and City staff will review each artist's work and associated materials submitted by the project deadline. Selected submissions will meet all of the requirements and demonstrate a high quality. The City of Austin reserves the right to disqualify materials deemed offensive or inappropriate to show in a public setting.
