The **City of Austin** recently commissioned a **Minority- and Women-Owned Business Enterprise (MBE/WBE) Disparity Study**. This study will examine the participation of MBEs and WBEs in public sector contracting and procurement activities over the last several years. **Travis County** and the **Austin Independent School District** are conducting similar disparity studies concurrently with the City's.

Gathering feedback from business owners is a very important part of each study. Each year, the City, the County and the School District purchase a wide variety of construction, consulting services, and other goods and services from business owners like you. These studies provide a unique opportunity for interested business owners to share their experiences and insights regarding both the opportunities and the challenges involved in doing business or attempting to do business with any or all of these three Austin-area governments.
