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

includes Health and Human Services & Children, Families, and Education



Plan Framework: Building Blocks

- **CE P9:** Reduce the carbon footprint of the city and its residents by implementing Austin's Climate Protection Plan and developing strategies to adapt to the projected impacts of climate change.
- **CE A1:** Implement the City of Austin Climate Protection Plan.
- LUT P1: Align land use and transportation planning and decision-making to achieve a compact and connected city in line with the Growth Concept Map.
- LUT P3: Promote development in compact centers, communities, or along corridors that are connected by roads and transit, are designed to encourage walking and bicycling, and reduce healthcare, housing and transportation costs.
- E P15: Invest in sustainable, affordable utility sources to meet the needs of increasing population and employment bases.
- CFS P24: Increase the share of renewable energy sources.


