2. Feedback on the TAG action lists
 - ENG did a nice job of laying out how they see 2030 and beyond; still will need offsets in 2050 because heating and cooking will use some gas
 - Sorting by impact; cost relative to the impact it nets
 - It'd be nice to see matrix of time/cost/barrier – multiple dimensions with interactive graphic – maybe for the implementation phase?
 - Need to convey stories with people, tied with the actions
 - There should be two presentations of data – policy that's been adopted and new actions and where they fit
3. Discussion of the reduction scenario graph options
 - Worst case – “do nothing” is unrealistic
 - Graph only shows the pain – need another dimension for the economics
 - Change wording to reflect our reaction “Gave up” “likely with leadership” “major commitment to transit”
 - Lead with success, can hear dire news after a positive
 - Try an area graph – label with new jobs or avoided health costs if possible

 - Use Google doc to edit so there are live updates and all edits in one place
 - Include implementation strategy, use top immediate actions in recommendations and how to move the needle now with tangible/visible actions
