AFFORDABILITY FOR TODAY AND TOMORROW


Save money, save energy – it's not just a tagline. The Texas Gas Service Conservation Program has been helping the Austin community save money and energy for more than a decade. Each year, more customers are choosing energy-efficient natural gas appliances thanks to the help of rebates, and those appliances continue to save them money on their utility bills each month.

An ongoing increase in the cost of living in the Austin area has significantly affected those who wish to call Austin home. It will take time and cooperation across organizations and agencies to help address the larger problem, but there are smaller-scale changes that can help in the meantime.

Texas Gas Service's Conservation Program is committed to being a part of the affordability solution by:

- Bridging the gap between natural gas appliance and electric appliance purchase costs. Rebates help customers afford a more efficient appliance than they may have purchased otherwise, leading to lower utility bills in the long run.
- Encouraging builders to offer natural gas as a fuel choice option. By building homes and apartments with natural gas plumbing and efficient appliances, the builder provides the homebuyer or renter the opportunity to save money on their utility bills long-term.
- Assisting low-income customers through the Free Equipment Program. Many Austinites struggle to make ends meet and simply cannot afford to purchase a more efficient natural gas appliance. The Free Equipment Program addresses this growing concern in the Austin community and makes it possible for those in need to have a more energy-efficient and affordable home.

Texas Gas Service's Conservation Program rebates and Free Equipment Program help customers offset the up-front cost of purchasing efficient natural gas appliances and encourage the most efficient use of energy for cooking, heating and drying.

Builders receive rebates that make building energy-efficient homes with natural gas appliance connections more cost-friendly.

AFFORDABLE TOMORROW:

Consumers pay approximately 75 to 150 percent less by using the natural gas version of an appliance compared with the electric version. And with the natural gas connections built in from the start, homeowners have the option to save on their utility bills throughout the entire life of the home.

New Construction – Tankless Water Heaters



AFFORDABLE TODAY:

Texas Gas Service customers get a \$225 rebate when they purchase a new natural gas dryer.

AFFORDABLE TOMORROW:

Texas Gas Service customers who installed natural gas dryers in FY2015 will save a combined total of more than \$350,000 over the life of the dryers compared with using an electric dryer.



LOOKING AHEAD

Texas Gas Service will continue to focus on efficiency and affordability in 2016. We plan to:

- Increase outreach for the Free Equipment Program to help customers in need of efficient appliances
- Educate contractors so they can help their customers choose natural gas appliances that lower their monthly utility bills
- Encourage builders and multi-family developers to create the infrastructure that allows for natural gas appliances and long-term savings

AFFORDABLE TODAY:

Texas Gas Service partners with CLEAResult to provide free installation of energy- and water-saving sink aerators, spray valves and showerheads for commercial customers, including local restaurants, hotels and other businesses.

AFFORDABLE TOMORROW:

These improvements can save small and medium businesses up to \$500 annually in addition to saving more than 6 million gallons of water each year.
