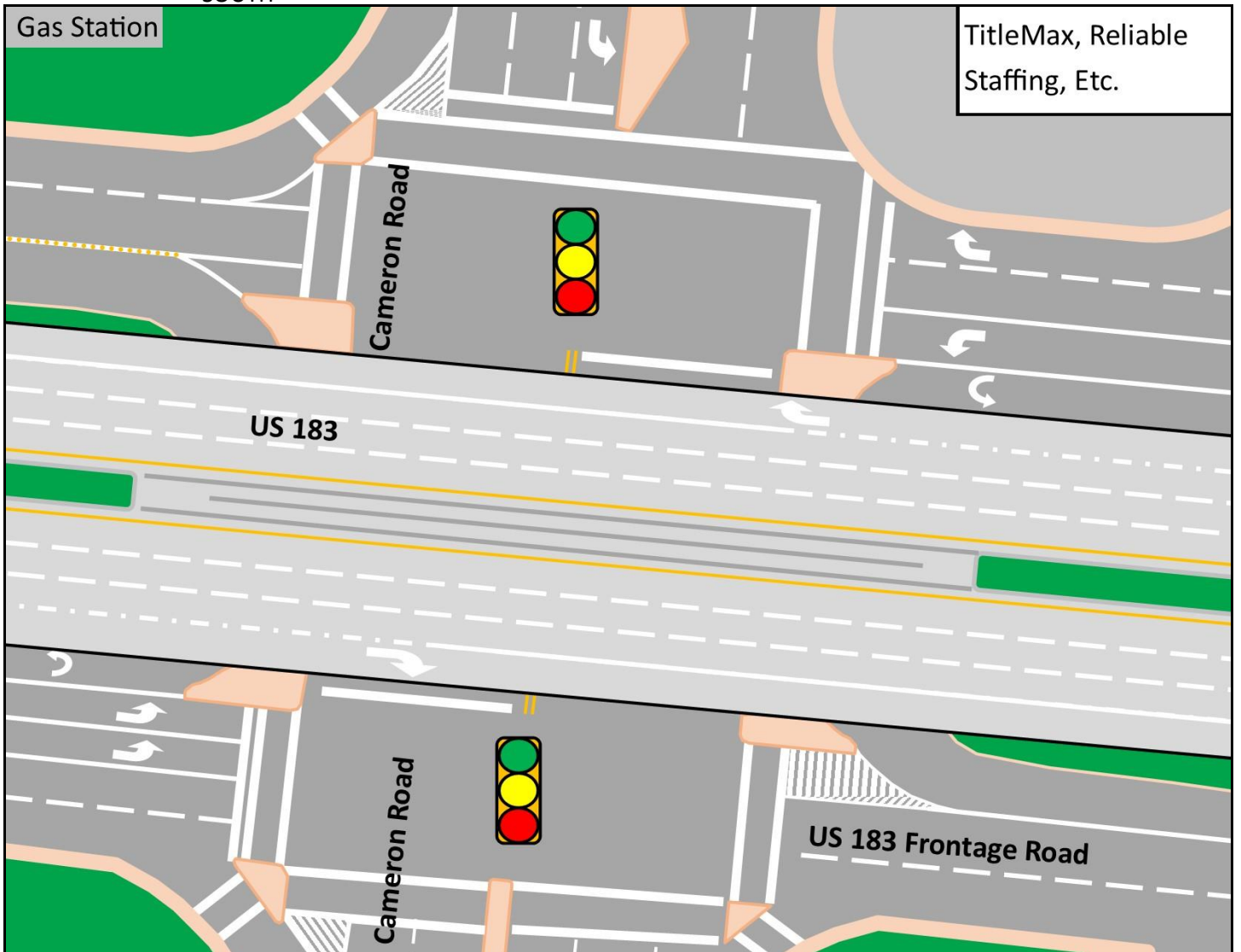
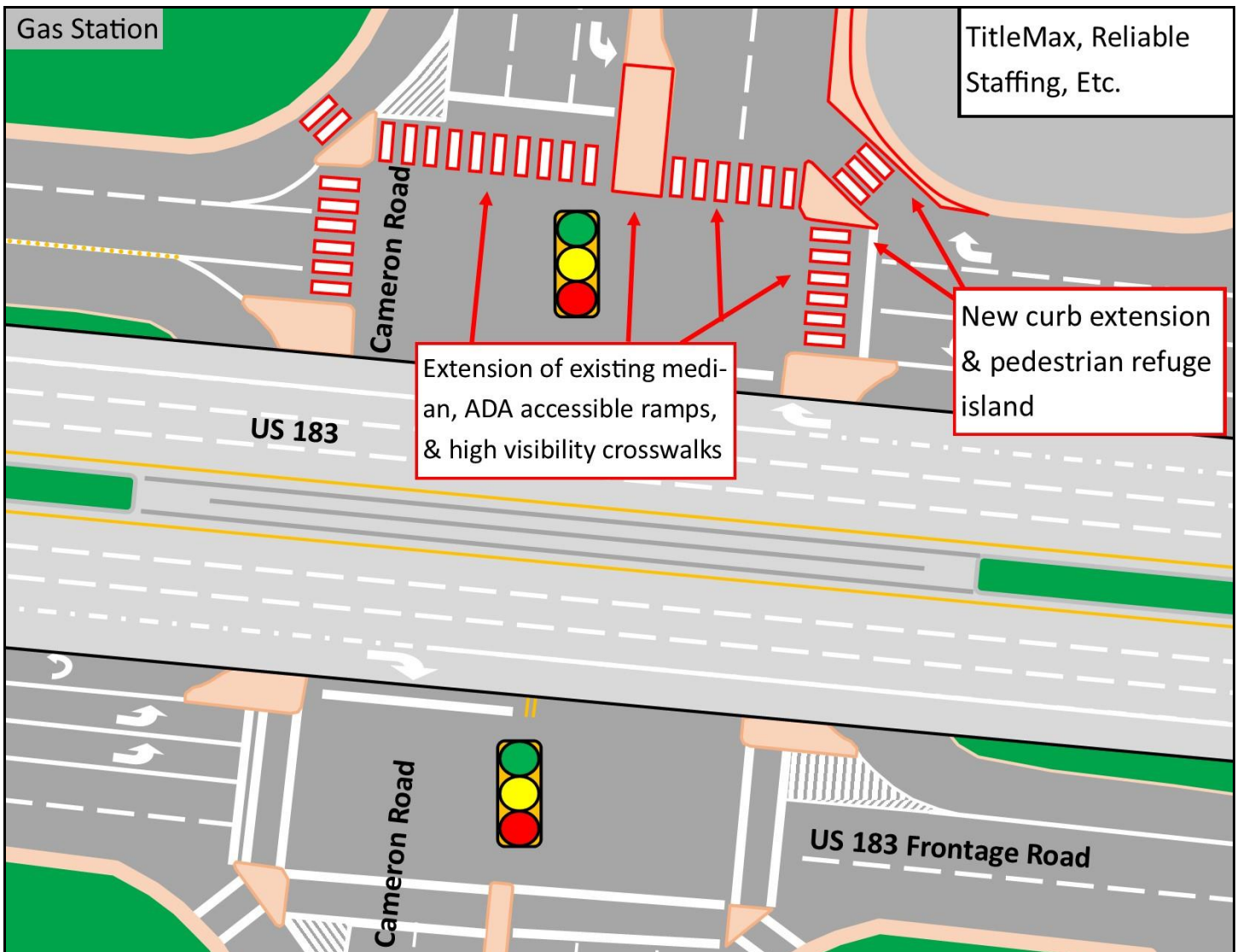

- Transportation Safety Improvements Completed –

Cameron Road at US 183 Frontage Road

Goal

Reduce documented incidents of vehicle/pedestrian and vehicle/vehicle crashes at the intersection of Cameron Road and the US 183 Frontage Road by installing enhanced pedestrian safety features and a new traffic signal warning device.

These improvements are part of the City Council-adopted Vision Zero Action Plan. The Plan includes using Evaluation, Enforcement, Engineering, Education and Policy to reduce traffic deaths in Austin to zero by 2025.

Improvements Completed

- Constructing a new right-turn channelized island/pedestrian refuge island at the northeast corner of the intersection.
- Lengthening the existing raised median on the north side of the intersection to provide a pedestrian refuge space mid-crosswalk.
- Adding high-visibility continental crosswalks to all pedestrian crossing points on the north side of the US 183 overpass.
- Constructing an advanced warning flasher on the eastbound frontage road, ahead of the traffic signal at US 183 Frontage and Cameron Road. The signal will flash only when the signal ahead is red for eastbound vehicles in order to alert drivers to slow down and stop ahead.
