Shared Street Pilot

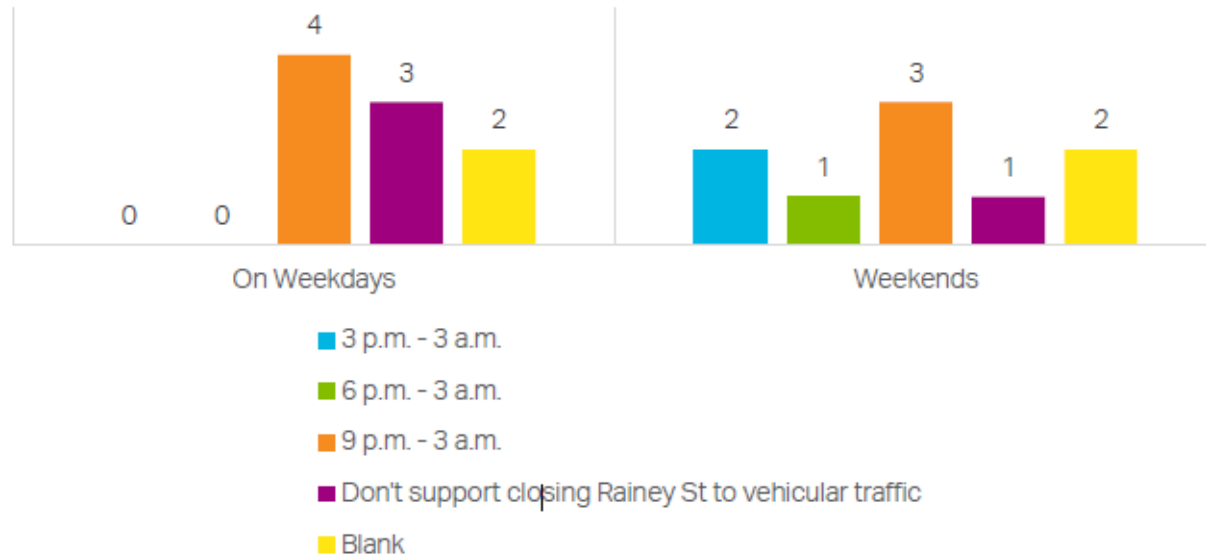
- What data was collected?
 - Answer: During the study traffic data and survey data were collected.
- When was the data collected?
 - Answer: Traffic data (MioVision video) from June 20, 2019 to June 22, 2019. Business Input Survey from August 12, 2019 to August 15, 2019.
- What dates and time of day were used to collect the data?
 - Answer: The traffic data was collected over a 72-hour period
- What are the results of the study?
 - Answer: The traffic data collected supported the decision from APD to conduct a “safety closure”. Both the survey data and pedestrian volumes influenced the times and days of the week for the street closure.

Data Collection

- Heavy pedestrian volumes starting on Thursday around 8:00 pm
- Peaking at 900 pedestrians on Saturday at 11:00 pm, making up to 80% of the total traffic
- More than 7,000 pedestrians counted between 6:00 pm and 2:00 am each Friday and Saturday night
