

Permitted Utility Piping System Providers

Cleaning and/or passivation of new utility piping systems, or cleaning, descaling, and/or coil cleaning of existing utility piping systems must be done by a permitted utility piping system provider to prevent certain cleaners, detergents, and corrosion inhibitors from leaching excessive chemicals and/or metals into the sanitary sewer system.
