NOTICE OF COMPLAINT

On August 17, 2022, the OPO received a phone complaint.

The complainant alleges: The past [REDACTED] months he has had tremendous issues with this crazy city and state. The people he has spoken to are either on one side or the other. He called 911 from the [REDACTED] on [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] because he felt his life and property were in danger. He had a nasty interaction with responding APD Officer [REDACTED]. The officer must have recorded the incident and if he didn't, he has issues with that. His main complaint is that he is being treated like an idiot. The Police & 311 distracted him from the process he was putting in motion by saying they were going to get back to him but did not. He was treated like dirt when APD called him and was given the run-around and laughed at. He wants all the records. Police have destroyed the records related to his incident. They tried to beat the crap out of him at [REDACTED] and he wants the video of that incident and the video of the incident at [REDACTED]. Google and the cloud have been hacked by APD and he wants that to be part of his complaint.

This notice of complaint is a request for Internal Affairs to initiate an investigation to determine if the employee conduct is within compliance of APD policy, Civil Service Rules, and Municipal Civil Service Rules.
