

## 2025 City of Austin Employee Youth Camp Scholarship Program

The 2025 Youth Camp Scholarship Program is open to all regular City of Austin employees with dependent children ages 5 through 12, and older children with special needs. If you plan to apply for a scholarship for an older student with special needs, please notify the PARD Inclusion Office by phone (512) 974-3914 or email <a href="mailto:inclusion@austintexas.gov">inclusion@austintexas.gov</a>. Employees can receive up to \$50 per child, per week reduction in the cost of spring break and summer camp fees at City of Austin Parks and Recreation Department (PARD) camps. Payments are only made for attendance at week-long, all-day camps.

You must apply for this program by the following deadlines to be approved for funding:

Spring Break - 5 p.m., February 14, 2025 Summer Break - 5 p.m., May 2, 2025

Only dependent children of regular City of Austin Employees are eligible for this program.

Eligible children include:

- Biological children, stepchildren, legally adopted children, children for whom you have obtained court-ordered guardianship or conservatorship, and qualified children place pending adoption.
- Dependent grandchildren for whom you have obtained court-ordered legal guardianship or conservatorship.

Nieces, nephews, visiting grandchildren, friend's children, etc., are not eligible.

To Use Your Scholarship to pay for a Spring Break or Summer Camp:

Contact the Parks and Recreation Department center(s) after you have secured a space in the camp(s) to notify staff that you have you have been awarded a Youth Camp Scholarship. You must notify the center prior to the final payment deadline, or you will be responsible for the full camp fee.

### Spring Break Camps require payment in full at registration.

Pay for the Spring Break Camp in full to secure a space in the camp. After you register, contact the center to notify staff that you have been awarded a scholarship. They will issue a refund for the scholarship amount.

Summer Camps require full or partial payments (a 'deposit' to hold a space in camp) at registration. Make a partial payment upon initial camp registration. Make all other payments due, minus the scholarship amount (\$50 per child, per week), prior to the payment deadline. Staff will apply the scholarship after the parents' portion of the class fees have been paid.
