## Lead & Healthy Homes

Lead is a poison that is most harmful to children and can cause learning disabilities, health deficiencies, and a weakened immune system, among many other problems. In order to prevent your child from coming into contact with this hazardous substance, NHCD has a [FREE grant](#) that can remove lead from your home.



## FREE services include:

- Up to \$30,000 in home repair and lead removal
- Lead-poisoning blood testing for children
- Home inspection for lead
- Removal of lead affected areas

## Am I Eligible?

- The property I live in was built before 1978 and is located within Austin and/or Travis County
- I have at least one child under the age of five that resides in my home OR visits more than six hours each week
- My household income is 80% or less than the Austin area median family income (MFI) - see chart below
- I am a renter, homeowner, or property manager
