## The Asian American Resource Center is seeking Instructors and Arts Counselors for Summer Camps 2015

The AARC is seeking **Arts Instructors, Arts Counselors** or **Senior Arts Counselors** to staff *Young Actors Studio: AARC Theatre Art Camp*, June 15 - August 7 (Monday - Friday) and teach students ages 5-16 in four two-week camps. Students will learn acting, theater production skills, art and craft making, while exploring Asian American history and multiculturalism. Staff must attend two training sessions: June 1-5 and TBD.

### **ARTS INSTRUCTOR I or II**

Will instruct campers on acting, performance and theatre arts. Hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Hourly wage is determined based on minimum qualifications and experience noted on Application.

Arts Instructor I - Minimum Qualifications (\$10.00/hour)

18 years and older, some college and 6 months experience,

Arts Instructor II - Minimum Qualifications (\$12.00/hour)

18 years and older, 2 years college and 6 months related experience. Two years of teaching can substitute for one year of college.

### **ARTS COUNSELOR**

Will serve as teacher's aide as well as organize and implement recreational games with students during out of classroom time. Hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. OR 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Minimum Qualifications (\$8.00/hour)

18 years and older, high school diploma/GED

### **SENIOR ARTS COUNSELOR**

Will serve as teacher's aide as well as organize and implement recreational games with students during out of classroom time. Hours are from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. OR 9 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Minimum Qualifications (\$9.00/hour)

18 years and older, high school diploma/GED and one year of experience. 2 years of college may substitute for required experience.
