# Trade Counter

at the Naturalist Workshop

Here's how it works:

## 1. Find

something when you're outside that's interesting to you.  
(Please read the flip side on rules for collecting.)

## 2. Learn

about your new nature item.

## 3. Bring

your item to the Trade Counter and share what you've learned. (An item can be a drawing or a photo or a written description of what you saw.)

## 4. Earn

points for your item AND your knowledge.

## 5. Use

your points by taking home something from our trade collection or save the points for later.





We accept these items for trade. (5 items max per trade)

Clean bones

Clean shells

Clean insects and crustacean exoskeletons

Snake sheds

Rocks and minerals

Fossils

Plant Parts (nuts, seeds, pressed leaves and flowers)

Antlers

Casts of animal footprints

Nature journal entries (drawings, descriptions, photos)

Bring only one each of the different specimens you find.  
You only need a few to make a good collection.

## Please don't bring us these items:

Anything collected on land where natural items  
are protected by law, like State and Federal parks

Arrowheads or other cultural artifacts

Animal skins, pelts or mounts

Birds or bird parts

(feathers, eggs, nests, etc)

Live or killed animals

Whole plants (one leaf is ok)
