History of Austin Pools

- First pools built in 1920's and 30's
- Early funding from a \$4.25 million bond issue approved in 1928
- Oldest Pools
 - Deep Eddy 1921
 - West Enfield 1931
 - Rosewood & Parque Zaragosa 1932
 - Metz & Shipe 1934
 - Stacy 1936
 - Brentwood, Govalle, Patterson 1954
 - Reed & Nothwest 1956
 - Givens 1958
- Now over 1.25 million visits to pools each year




Pools

- 11 Splash Pads




Pools Attendance (2011-2012)


