

# **Barton Springs Pool General Grounds Improvements Project**

Update: December 13, 2013

Trail of Lights is in progress. Here are the details for pool access:

Barton Springs Pool is open AT ALL TIMES during normal hours. The south lot and entrance is currently closed for construction.

**Access and ADA parking to the pool during road closure times is via Mopac. Enter the “permit parking lane” and tell the parking staff you are a swimmer.**

A note again that the contractor has been able to set aside an open lawn area for patrons. See signage inside the pool area or ask staff to show you. The bike racks were moved to use near temporary entrance. If you left a lock, it may still be there.

## **Work completed:**

- Re-alignment of south hike and bike trail
- Pier holes for north suspended walkway; concrete and reinforcing steel for piers has been installed
- Curbing around new north bike rack area (adjacent to tree island in parking lot)

## **Work in progress:**

- Replacing ADA ramp on north west –Opening Wednesday December 19
- Electric service work on south side
- Grading for work on south woods path

## **Work expected in next two weeks:**

- Continued work on the tree court area
- Grade south eroded path
- Continued work on south woods path

## **Potential Inconveniences:**

- Lawn access will continue to be restricted.
- The pool entrance has been temporarily relocated to the west end of the bathhouse.

- For the duration of the project, the South Hike and Bike trail will be closed on weekdays. It will be open on weekends, unless otherwise posted. **New alignment will be open as of December 14/15.**

**Note: Trail of Lights has a gate closed across the detour route, but pedestrians and bikes can go around it.**
