

General Comments from July 10, 2013 Meeting
Auditorium Shores Improvements Project: Off-Leash Area

The individual comments listed below reflect a summary of notes taken by City staff and are not necessarily reflective of the consensus opinion of meeting attendants.

1. Find ways to further reduce the runner/dog trail conflict
2. Human traffic far greater than dog traffic, humans should be given higher priority
3. Install a temporary dock for the dogs to have access to the water while new OLA is under construction
4. Remove brush and invasive species from middle section shore area before constructing new OLA
5. Shoreline erosion – what’s the plan?
6. Would like to see the middle section as part of the OLA when no events are scheduled
7. More enforcement of OLA vs Non-OLA needed
8. Need defined barrier for OLA – lots of greenery, shrubs, etc. – NO FENCING!!!!
9. Fun Fun Fun Fest requested use of the OLA during their event. *Most of the public did not favor this idea
10. Turfgrass, not mulch preferred in the OLA
11. OLA needs plenty of trashcans and mutt mitt stations
12. Move the OLA boundary closer to Riverside Drive
13. Add human & dog fountains to the OLA
14. Provide a hose/rinse station in the OLA
15. Provide signage for OLA, Restrooms, Trail Directions, etc.
