VISITOR'S FAQs

Admission Fees- Admission to the Julia C. Butridge Gallery is always free. For performances and events in the theater, there may be a ticket fee to enter. Please visit our events page to obtain information on ticket pricing for these events.

Accessibility- The Dougherty Arts Center's theater and program spaces, as well as its exhibition galleries are all wheelchair accessible. The City of Austin is proud to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act. If you require assistance for participation in our programs or use of our facilities, please call (512) 974-3914.

Restrooms- Restrooms are located on each floor of the Dougherty Arts Center. A family restroom is located in the entrance of the East Gallery space.

Water fountains- Water fountains are located at both side entrances of the theater, as well as in the entrance of the East Gallery space.

Food/Drink- Food and drink are allowed in the Julia C. Butridge Gallery and Creative Rehearsal Spaces. Only bottled water and baby food are allowed in the Theater. No exceptions.

Service Animals- Only identified leashed or harnessed service animals are allowed in all areas of the Dougherty Arts Center.

Minors- All minors must be accompanied by an adult in all areas of the Dougherty Arts Center. Groups with minors must have one adult for every 10 children in attendance.

Photography- Photography is allowed and encouraged at the Dougherty Arts Center! Please be mindful, however, of how close you are in proximity to the art. Touching and handling art could damage the work and strictly prohibited.
