

Why Are We Here?




Shipe Pool, originally built in 1934, is currently classified as a 'critical pool' per the Austin Aquatic Facilities Needs Assessment.





Project Goals


Design should uniquely reflect the history, landscape and character of The Hyde Park Neighborhood and site





Pool Depth Usable Space Comparison


















Shade Structure





Pool Layout





60% of stakeholders favored side by side pool layout
