Registration

Registration for Camp Gonnahavefun begins **Saturday, February 23 at 9:00 a.m.** and ends at 12 p.m. (or until all spaces are filled). During registration, an individual may **ONLY** register his/her family. Children from two different households cannot be registered by the same person. Space in **BOTH** age groups for each session is limited! Once a session becomes full, participants may be added to a wait list.

Age Groups

5 years old - Entering 2nd Grade

Entering 3rd Grade - Entering 6th Grade

Parents/Guardians may enroll their child/children in camp by paying a \$20 deposit for each week they want their child/children to attend camp. The remaining balance is then due 2 weeks prior to the program start date. If the balance is not received by 6:00 p.m. on the due date, the child's space and the \$20 deposit* will automatically be forfeited and customers on the waiting list will be contacted.

Cost

\$130 total per session

\$20 deposit per session due at registration

Payments accepted in cash, check, or credit. If you are paying with cash please have exact change.

*Deposits are non-refundable, but may be transferred to your account if the request is made in writing by 6:00 p.m. on Friday, May 24, 2013. Deposits cannot be transferred after May 24. The program fee is refunded in full only if the class is canceled by the Austin Parks and Recreation Department.
