

Wooldridge Square Preliminary Plan Public Meeting #3

The Austin Parks and Recreation Department will host a stakeholder and community meeting to present the completed Preliminary Plan for Wooldridge Square. The meeting format is primarily informational. Attendees will have the opportunity to review the completed plan that incorporates input received from various stakeholders and research conducted by consultants DWG. Information will be provided regarding the City of Austin Boards and Commissions review process for “adoption” of the plan.

The purpose of the preliminary plan is to improve the park with intentional programming that supports stakeholder recommendations, in addition to those outlined in the Downtown Parks and Open Space Master Plan and the Downtown Austin Plan of 2010. The proposed preliminary plan seeks to consider the context and the historical status of this downtown square and incorporate a stakeholder process with the leadership of Downtown Austin Alliance, Travis County, Friends of Wooldridge Square, Austin History Center, Preservation Austin, Texas Historical Commission, and the Austin Parks Foundation.
