

Project Scope & Description – Council District 8

- Project will install 4 boulders (boulders provided by PARD)
- Backfill wall with sandy loam select 6" or less from top of wall; install a split rail fence & purchase Kiosk
- Project feasibility has been reviewed and approved by staff at the Parks and Recreation Department.


