\* <u>I</u> understand that once the City of Austin receives and processes this Vacancy Exemption Request, this property will be exempted from billing the Transportation User Fee <u>until the property is no</u> longer vacant, or 3 months, whichever occurs first.

\* \_\_\_\_\_ If the property remains vacant after 3 months, the account owner must submit a new signed Vacancy Exemption Request, otherwise this property will begin billing the Transportation User Fee.

\* \_\_\_\_\_ No refunds or credits will be granted for fees paid in months not covered by a current Vacancy Exemption Request.

\* \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that at any time the City of Austin may visit this property and verify the information I have provided. If it is determined the information is incorrect, the City shall have the right to recover all monies owed by me to the City as a result of this information and shall initiate billing of this fee immediately. The reimbursement to the City shall date back to the date I initially requested for the exemption.

\* \_\_\_\_\_ I understand that I am to notify the City of Austin should the property become occupied and the utility bill remains in my name.
