Architect Technician - Under general supervision, using broad knowledge of architecture technology concepts, principles, and practices, evaluate simple to complex architecture technology support functions including researching, reviewing, analyzing and providing information to other team members. Perform a wide variety of standard and nonstandard tasks in architecture technology functions. Associate degree in Applied Science or a related engineering discipline may substitute for 2 years of the required work experience.	
Architect Technician I (1-5)	Graduation from High School or equivalent, plus more than 1-5 years of related work experience.
Architect Technician II (5-10)	Graduation from High School or equivalent, plus more than 5-10 years of related work experience.
Architect Technician III (10-15)	Graduation from High School or equivalent, plus more than 10-15 years of related work experience.
Architect Technician IV (15-20)	Graduation from High School or equivalent, plus more than 15-20 years of related work experience.
Architect Technician V (20-25)	Graduation from High School or equivalent, plus more than 20-25 years of related work experience.

Architect Associate I (0-5)	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in a field related to architecture, plus more than 0-5 years of related work experience.
Architect Associate II (5-10)	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in a field related to architecture, plus more than 5-10 years of related work experience.
Architect Associate III (10-15)	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in a field related to architecture, plus more than 10-15 years of related work experience, plus 1 year in a lead capacity.
Architect Associate IV (15-20)	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in a field related to architecture, plus more than 15-20 years of related work experience, plus 1 year in a lead capacity.
Architect Associate V (20-25)	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in a field related to architecture, plus more than 20-25 years of related work experience, plus 1 year in a lead capacity.
Architect Associate VI (25+)	Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in a field related to architecture, plus more than 25+ years of related work experience, plus 1 year in a lead capacity.

Supervisory Architect I (8-10)	Professional Architect Registration required. Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in architecture, plus more than 8-10 years of architecture work experience, 2 years of which were in a lead or supervisory capacity.
Supervisory Architect II (10-12)	Professional Architect Registration required. Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in architecture, plus more than 10-12 years of architecture work experience, 2 years of which were in a lead or supervisory capacity.
Supervisory Architect III (12-15)	Professional Architect Registration required. Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in architecture, plus more than 12-15 years of architecture work experience, 2 years of which were in a lead or supervisory capacity.

Graduation from an accredited four-year college or university with major course work in architecture, or in a field related to the job, plus more than 10-12 years of architecture work experience, 6 years of work experience acquired after registration as a professional architect, 4 years of which were in a supervisory capacity.
Managing Architect III (12-15)	Professional Architect Registration required.
