

# 2016 Mobility Bond: Intersection Safety/Vision Zero

## Planned Intersection Safety Improvements

Slaughter Lane & Cullen Lane

### OVERVIEW

The planned improvements to Slaughter Lane at Cullen Lane are designed to increase safety and improve mobility by adding raised medians, upgrading signals, and improving pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure.

### PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- Increased storage space for cars waiting to turn left on Slaughter Lane
- Upgraded signals on Slaughter Lane to exclusive left-turn arrows
- Upgraded pedestrian infrastructure, including high-visibility crosswalks across Cullen Lane
- Enhanced bicycle pavement markings crossing Cullen Lane

### TIMELINE

- Anticipated construction start:  
Late Fall 2018
- Construction anticipated to last 3 months

*\*Barring weather delays or other unforeseen circumstances*

### FUNDING

This project is anticipated to cost \$300,000.

### 2016 MOBILITY BOND

The 2016 Mobility Bond dedicates \$15 million of Local Mobility funding towards Intersection Safety/Vision Zero projects, including construction of improvements at top crash intersections around Austin.




