REQUIREMENTS FOR EXCAVATION (EX) PERMITS

If you are performing any kind of excavation (removing or otherwise disturbing soil), this is the permit you will need.

STEPS TO OBTAIN AN EXCAVATION PERMIT

- 1. Secure an approved Traffic Control Plan (TCP) for the affected Right of Way; if a Standard Closure Detail is not applicable, the plan must have an Engineer's Seal. https://www.austintexas.gov/page/right-way-traffic-control
- 2. Submit an Excavation application through the ABC Portal at https://abc.austintexas.gov.
- 3. Identify a Licensed Right of Way Contractor who will perform the excavation work. Determine who will obtain the permit. A Licensed ROW Contractor may obtain permits directly OR name you as an Authorized Agent who can obtain permits on their behalf. To become an Authorized Agent for a Licensed Right of Way Contractor, please have the contractor complete the Authorized Agent form. - **4.** Provide any applicable documentation and pay remaining EX fees; Excavation permits can then be activated by Right of Way Management.

NOTE: IF THE EXCAVATED AREA WILL BE <u>300 FEET OR GREATER</u> THEN IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE <u>AUSTIN UTILITY LOCATION COORDINATION COMMITTEE MEETING (AULCC).</u>

IF THE EXCAVATED AREA WILL BE <u>25 FEET OR GREATER</u> AND LIES WITHIN THE <u>DOWNTOWN AUSTIN PROJECT</u> <u>COORDINATION ZONE (DAPCZ)</u> THEN IT WILL BE NECESSARY TO ATTEND <u>DAPCZ AND AULCC MEETINGS.</u>

STEP 3 – IDENTIFY A LICENSED RIGHT OF WAY CONTRACTOR

STEP 4 – DOCUMENTATION AND FEES

EXCAVATION DOCUMENTATION

- 1. Provide evidence of City of Austin project consent via an approved -- Site Plan, Utility Plan, General Permit, Building/Demo Permit, CIP, Small Cell Permit, and/or UCC tracking number(s). If available, please provide your Inspector Name.
- 2. Provide an approved Temporary Traffic Control Plan. If a City of Austin Standard Detail applies please list the specific detail number, otherwise provide an Engineer's Sealed Plan. The plan must be specific to the right of way excavation work. **SEE "STEP 1 TRAFFIC CONTROL PLAN (TCP)"**
- 3. Provide evidence that commercial right of way development fees have been paid to Sites & Subdivisions.
- 4. **Protected Streets:** Protected Streets require a Street Cut Justification Letter and Restoration/Paving Plan. Click here to view the "Protected Street List for Developers" ("Related Links" section of webpage).
- 5. **Utility Crossings:** Utility Crossings may require a Horizontal View and Bore Profile sealed and signed by a Professional Engineer licensed by the State of Texas.

AUSTIN UTILITY LOCATION AND COORDINATION COMMITTEE (AULCC)

Per City of Austin ordinance 14-11-165, the **Utility Location and Coordination** Committee shall convene regularly to address the <u>identification of facilities in the right-of-way</u>, <u>resolution of conflicts in location of facilities</u>, AND <u>coordination of plans for excavation in the right-of-way</u>. If the excavated area will be **300 feet or greater**, it will be necessary to contact our office at 512-974-7828 and request to be added to the AULCC agenda.

DOWNTOWN AUSTIN PROJECT COORDINATION ZONE (DAPCZ)

Per City of Austin ordinance 14-11-167, a person who seeks to excavate in the **Downtown Austin Project Coordination Zone** must submit a project description. If this requirement applies to you AND if the excavated area will be **25 feet or greater**, it will be necessary to contact our office at 512-974-7828 and request to be added to both the DAPCZ and AULCC agendas. Per ordinance, a project description should be submitted "to the director: 1) no later than January 1 for an excavation to begin after January 30 and before July 1; or 2) no later than July 1 for an excavation to begin after July 30 and before January 1."

Details should include contact phone and e-mail, ROW ID, and project name, location, description, manager, owner, start date, duration, status, bidding, and a current update on the project.
